## Owensboro Public Schools Kindergarten & Preschool Registration

March 5-16, 2012

**8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at the school your child will attend**

Owensboro Public Schools will be accepting registration for all students who will attend preschool or kindergarten for the first time next year. If you need to know what school your child will attend, call 686-1000. For more information about Hager Preschool, call 686-1125.

### **To Register for Kindergarten**

Visit the elementary school your child will attend and complete an application. Registering your child is very important in helping schools to prepare for next year. If you are not sure which school your child will attend, please call 686-1000.

**Kindergarten** registration is available to children who will be 5 years old by Oct. 1, 2012. Kindergarten is a full-day program Monday through Friday. Students who are currently attending Hager Preschool will register at the school they will attend in the fall.

**Preschool** registration: Hager Preschool will begin accepting applications March 5-16 for the 2012-13 state-funded KERA preschool/Head Start program. Preschool is available free of charge to children who will be 3 or 4 years old by Oct. 1, 2012, AND whose families meet income eligibility guidelines. This program is also available to 3- and 4-year old children who are determined to have a developmental delay in one or more of the following developmental areas: speech/language, cognition (learning), social skills, or motor development. To register, please call 686-1125 to schedule an appointment with a Family Advocate PRIOR to March 5, 2012. Hager Preschool is located at 1701 West 7th Street (located immediately behind Foust Elementary School).

**Enrollment forms** can be downloaded from the Owensboro Public Schools' Web Site Home Page at: <http://www.owensboro.kyschools.us/enrollment/>. Those forms can be filled out online, printed, and taken to the school. Forms will also be available at the school at the time of registration.

**What to bring to registration:** Items your child's school will need for new student enrollment include original birth certificate (copies will be made at the school), child's Social Security card (copies will be made at the school), and the following medical records on a Kentucky form only: physical examination record, immunization certificate, vision examination record by an eye doctor and a dental screening/exam performed after the child's 5<sup>th</sup> birthday.
